NFPA Issues Safety Alert on SCBA Face Pieces and Lenses

Recently, the <u>National Fire Protection Association</u> issued a safety alert on self-contained breathing apparatuses ("<u>SCBA</u>") face-piece lenses. The NFPA is recommending that all SCBA face-piece lenses be inspected before and after each use.

The <u>National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health</u> ("NIOSH") conducted an investigation of firefighter fatalities that occurred between 2002 and 2011. NIOSH found evidence of thermal degradation of face-piece lenses. Concerns with face-piece lenses identified by NIOSH were brought before the NFPA Technical Committee on Respiratory Protection Equipment, which issued the safety alert.
