

CFIUS Clearance: Capgemini and Leidos Cyber

In 2018, [Capgemini SE](#), a French multinational corporation providing consulting, professional, technology and outsourcing services announced that it had entered into an agreement to acquire Leidos Cyber, the “commercial cybersecurity arm” of the US company [Leidos Holdings Inc.](#) (NYSE:LDOS). (Capgemini SE Press Release, “[Capgemini to acquire Leidos Cyber, the commercial cybersecurity division of Leidos](#),” June 7, 2018). “The completion of the acquisition [was] subject to anti-trust and Committee of Foreign Investment in the United States (CFIUS) approvals.” (*Id.*). In February 2019, Capgemini SE closed the acquisition, announcing that this had followed approval of all regulatory requirements.
