Check the List: Is OFCCP Ready to Release Your Company's EEO-1 Report?

In response to a <u>Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request</u> from the Center for Investigative Reporting, the Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs (OFCCP) is <u>preparing to release</u> the 2016-0220 EEO-1 Type 2 (Consolidated) reports of federal contractors that did not previously object to disclosure. OFCCP's <u>List of Non-Objectors</u> identifies more than 13,000 entities whose EEO-1 reports OFCCP plans to release in response to the FOIA request.

Entities on the non-objector list can still object to OFCCP's release of this information via email until 11:59 p.m. on February 7, 2023. Entities are eligible to lodge an objection to disclosure if they can provide supporting information that they were not a federal contractor during the relevant period or they previously submitted an objection to the release of their Type 2 reports.
