FTC To Host Virtual Public Forum

As we recently reported, in January 2023, the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) announced a <u>proposed nationwide ban on non-compete clauses</u>. The proposed rule would restrict employers from enforcing all existing and future non-compete agreements with their employees.
