New Rule Harmonises EAR and ITAR Destination Control Statements

The **US Commerce Department**'s Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) and the State Department's Directorate of Defense Trade Controls (DDTC) each issued companion final rules (see <u>here</u> and <u>here</u>) that will amend the EAR and the ITAR, respectively, to harmonise the destination control statement language provided in both sets of regulations. These actions are the latest in a series taken pursuant to the President's Export Control Reform initiative. Both rules will take effect on 15 November 2016.
